NOTICE OF RACE

The 2020 Winter Series will be held on the following Sunday's during August and September 2020: August 2nd, 9th, 16th and the 23rd, September 6th, 13th. The organising authority for this regatta is Mordialloc Sailing Club Inc. The regatta will be conducted by Mordialloc Sailing Club Inc.

1. Rules

The event will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), the Class Rules of participating classes and the Prescriptions and Special Regulations of Australian Sailing (AS).

Australian Sailing Special Regulations, Part 2, Off The Beach Boats will apply.

2 Advertising

RRS 80 applies.

3. Eligibility and Entry

3.1 Entries will be accepted for any class of mono hull off the beach dinghy, catamaran & Flying 15. Racing will be based on yardstick grouped divisions.

3.2 Eligible boats may enter for the series by completing the attached Entry Form, which shall be lodged with the Race Secretary of Mordialloc Sailing Club Inc by 1200hrs on the first day of entry. Day entry may be made by completing the attached form which shall be lodged with the Race Secretary of Mordialloc Sailing Club Inc by 1200 hrs on the first day of entry. Subsequent day entries require payment of fees only.

4. Fees

The Entry Fee for the series is:

Non MSC members:	\$70.00 for single/double handed dinghy or catamaran	(Adult)
	\$50.00 for single/double handed dinghy or catamaran	(Junior, under 18)

The Day Entry Fee is:

Non MSC members:	\$15.00 for single/double handed dinghy or catamaran	(Adult)
	\$10.00 for single/double handed dinghy or catamaran	(Junior, under 18)

MSC members: No entry fee applies.

There is a maximum of two races scheduled for each race day, the start times for subsequent races on each day will be as soon as practical after the conclusion of the preceding race, at the discretion of the Principal Race Officer.

6. Measurement

All competing yachts shall conform to the measurement requirements specified in the appropriate class rules. Measurement checks may be carried out at any time during the regatta.

7. Sailing Instructions

Sailing Instructions will be available from the Race Secretary of Mordialloc Sailing Club Inc. at registration.

9. Racing Area

The racing area will be on the waters of Port Phillip off Mordialloc Sailing Club.

10. Courses

The format and courses to be sailed will be detailed in the Sailing Instructions.

11. Penalty System

For the 29er, 49er, B14, Wazp, Moth and Musto Skiff classes, and all catamaran classes, rule 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.

12. Scoring

The Low Points Scoring System specified in Appendix A will apply as modified below.

- 12.1 A maximum of 12 races are scheduled, of which 5 races shall be completed to constitute a series.
- 12.2 When fewer than 6 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
- 12.3 When from 6 to 10 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.
- 12.4 When 11 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst two scores.

13. Personal Flotation

All competitors shall wear personal flotation devices, which are in good condition and are in accordance with the specifications issued or approved by a national authority affiliated to the International Sailing federation, or a standards organisation, or certification authority, recognised for the purpose by its respective government. Attention is drawn to Fundamental Rule 1.2.



14. Support Boats

- 14.1. Only registered coaches will be permitted in the race area, registration can be obtained by application to the Mordialloc Sailing Club representative on the day of registration.
- 14.2. All other support personnel shall keep to leeward and more than 100 metres clear of any competitor or mark of the course between the preparatory signal and expiration of race time, except when asked to assist by the Race Committee. Failure to comply may result in protest of boats associated with the infringing vessel.

15. Prizes

Prizes will be awarded at the discretion of Mordialloc Sailing Club Inc. Trophies will be presented at the conclusion of racing each race day.

16. Entry Disclaimer

It is the competitor's decision to enter the Event or to start and continue in any race. Competitors shall accept that their participation in the Event is at their exclusive risk in every respect. See Rule 4, Decision to Race. The Organising Authority, and the host club, their officers, members, servants and agents accept no responsibility in respect of loss of life, personal injury or loss or damage to property which may be sustained by reason of their participation or intended participation in this Event or howsoever arising in connection with this Event.

17. Insurance

All boats shall have third party insurance cover of not less than \$AUD10,000,000 or equivalent thereof in any other currency for any accident. All owners/competitors who sign the entry forms are deemed to have made a declaration that they hold such cover. Owner/competitors not holding this cover shall withdraw their entry.
